



REGATHERING FOR SUNDAY SCHOOL AND CHURCH PROGRAMMING

updated 8/17/2020

We are preparing to regather for Sunday School and other church related programs. This includes offering Sunday school for all ages on Sunday morning, nursery and preschool care during worship, and all other church programs that have been postponed during the Covid-19 pandemic. The date for regathering will be Sunday September 6th. **Beginning September 6th our Sunday morning worship time will revert back to 11am.**

The following outlines what you can expect to experience beginning September 6th.

WORSHIP SERVICE // We will continue to offer live worship at 11am and the sermon will be available on our website later during the week. We are working to offer a Live Stream soon in the near future.

CLEANNES AND SAFETY PROCEDURES //

Children's Environments:

- Volunteers have been trained on updated sanitation guidelines.
- All equipment and environments will be cleaned and sanitized before and after service. This includes cribs, mattresses, chairs, tables, toys, etc.
- Sanitation stations will be available at each point of entry. Children will be asked to sanitize hands upon entry to ministry space.
- We will ask attendees to self-screen before attending church. Anyone experiencing fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.
- Temperature checks will be administered to all children by an approved volunteer via Non-Contact Infrared Digital Thermometers. Any temperature over 100.2 will be considered a fever and we ask that family please return home.
- Any child that is showing signs of general non-well being during activities will have their temperature checked with Non-Contact Digital Thermometers and the parent will be contacted. If a child is sick, the parent will be contacted immediately and they will be removed from their environment while waiting for the parent to arrive.
- We encourage single parent drop off/pick up to limit contact.
- Toys that are unused or unnecessary have been removed to promote healthy environments. There will be no cloth or stuffed animals.

Student Environments:

- The environment will be cleaned and sanitized before and after service.
- Sanitation stations will be available at each point of entry for use before entering.
- We will ask students to self-screen before attending church. Anyone experiencing fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.
- Temperature checks will be administered to all students by an approved volunteer via Non-Contact Infrared Digital Thermometers. Any student with a temperature over 100.2 will be asked to return home.
- Seating will be adjusted to provide adequate room for social distancing.
- Masks are required in places that social distancing measures are not feasible.

Adult Environments:

- Sanitation Stations will be available at each point of entry for use before entering.
- We will ask adults to self-screen before attending church. Anyone experiencing fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.
- Temperature checks will be administered to all adults by an approved volunteer via Non-Contact Infrared Digital Thermometers. Any adult with a temperature over 100.2 will be asked to return home.
- Seating will be adjusted to provide adequate room for social distancing.
- We ask that elevator usage be limited to those who require it and that only one person(family) per trip.
- For the foreseeable future we will not be offering refreshments during meetings.
- We ask that we refrain from hugs, handshakes, and physical contact with other people.
- Based on the Governor's face mask order (June 26) attendees are encouraged to wear a face mask for their safety and the safety of others, especially when social distancing is not an option.
